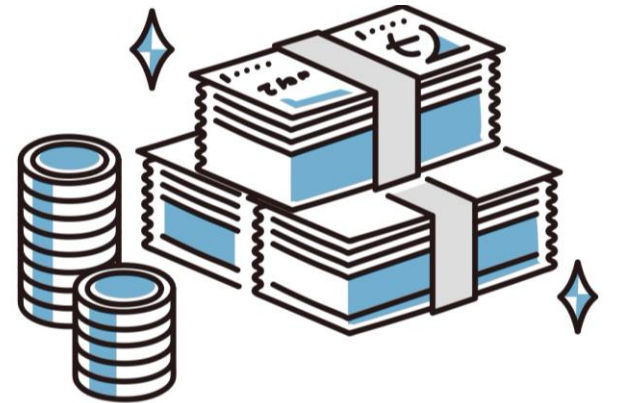
# IN THE CASE OF JAPAN

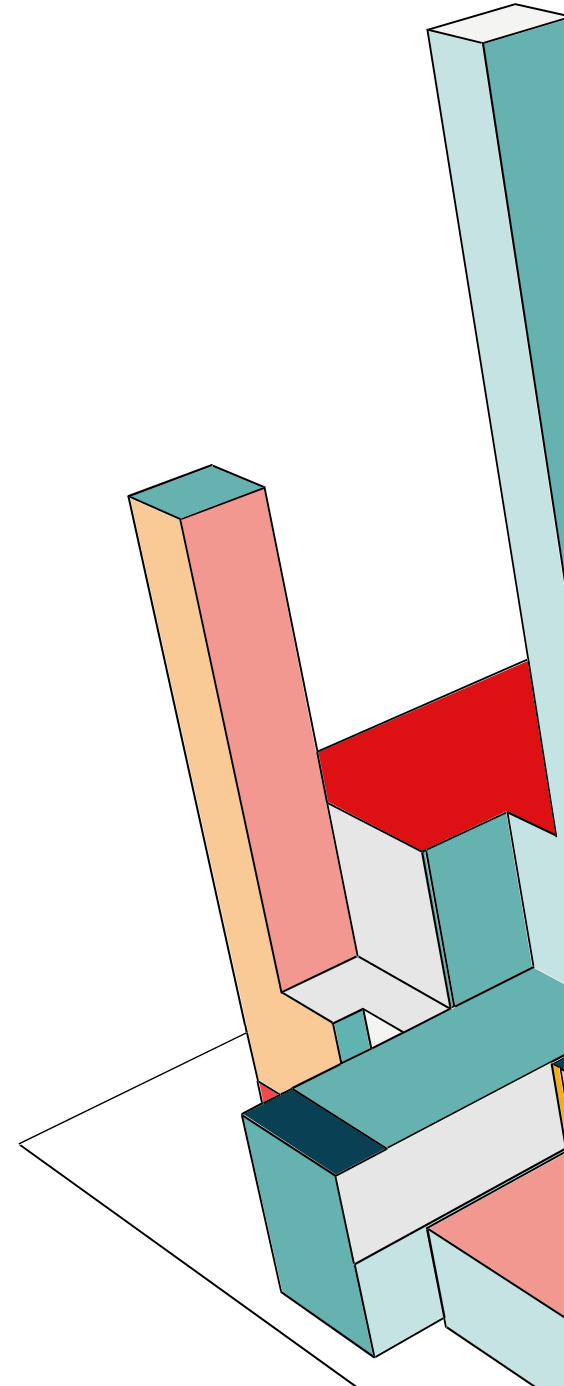
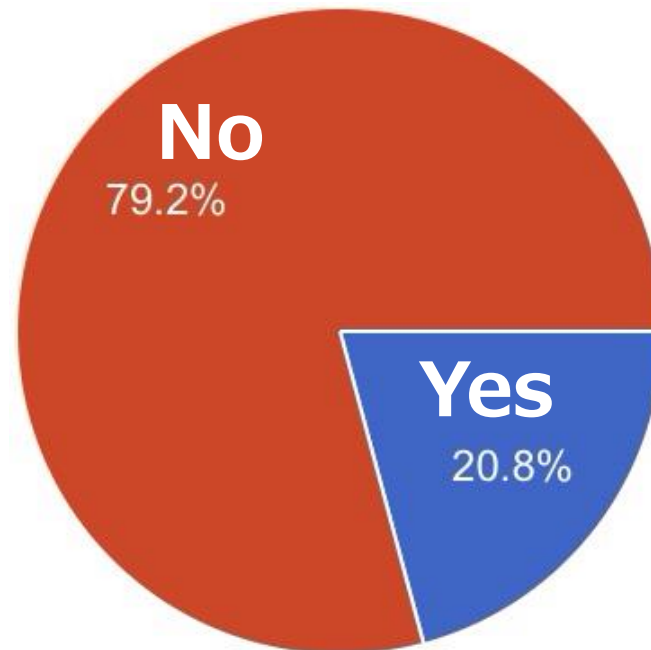
# RESULT

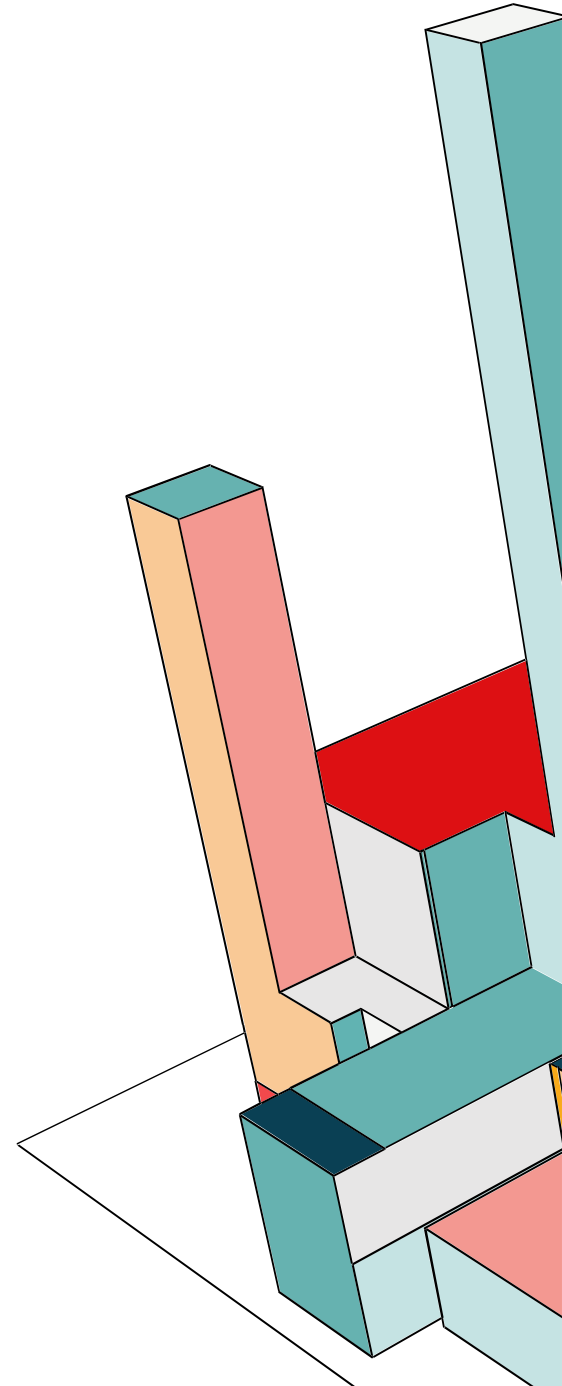

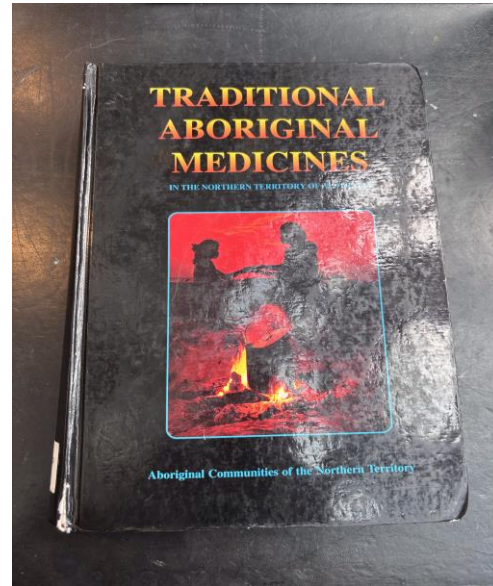
